LACK OF CAREER CONSISTENCY

<u>No Record of Sustained Elite Play</u>

- The first two years of his career he performed below average.
- The third year he had a solid season, but sustained a season ending injury.
- One outlier season, in his platform year, is not sufficient evidence of sustainable elite performance.

HISTORY OF PHYSICAL INJURIES <u>Prone to Injury Related Regression</u>

- Speed and explosiveness are the cornerstone of Duran's game.
- At 28 years old, with a history of foot injuries, these critical areas of his game are likely to decline.
- Toward the end of his 2024 season, he appeared fatigued furthering these sustainability concerns.



 The risk of reoccurring injuries and injury related regression is a significant concern.

 Riley's 2021 platform season was nothing short of elite. He hit 0.303 with 33 home runs and 107 RBI, finishing with an OPS of 0.898 over 160 games. These numbers earned Riley a \$3,950,000 salary in arbitration (a Club win).

• Riley was more consistent in the years before his platform season and just as good as Mr. Duran during it, however, **Riley lost a similar arbitration case** leading him to make \$3,950,000 million.

• Mr. Duran's platform year pales in comparison, with fewer home runs, RBI, and a lower OPS. O'Neil also won similar awards to Mr. Duran being top 10 in MVP voting and winning a Golden Glove.
